SCRAMBLE FORMAT RULES

The format for this tournament is a four person scramble.

This format requires that all players start from the appropriate tee markers. After all four players' initial drives, the designated captain must select the one ball to be played next. The position of the ball is marked and all players bring their balls to this mark. Balls must be placed no more than 6" in radius from the ball chosen. Players can place the ball on the ground but cannot improve the lie (i.e. if a ball chosen lies in a hazard or rough, all balls must be played from that lie within the 6" radius. You cannot deliberately improve the conditions.) However, if your ball is in a bunker you can give yourself a preferred lie this year as the bunkers will not be raked.

This process is repeated on each shot until the ball is holed. One score is recorded for the foursome. All four players must take a shot in sequence from each chosen ball. No player may hit a shot on behalf of another member of their team.

In the case of a threesome, the fourth shot shall be rotated through the three players through the 18 holes. A minimum of three drives per player must be used during the round. These drives must be clearly marked on the scorecard and the player responsible for each drive must be recorded.

It is the responsibility of the captain to ensure that the proper names of each player in the group are clearly marked on the scorecard and the player responsible for each drive must be recorded.

It is the responsibility of the captain to ensure that all of the rules of the format are upheld. Any violation of the above rules shall lead to disqualification of the entire team.

Please keep the course beautiful. Fix your ball marks and fill your divots. Follow the cart path at the end of the day.

In the interest of fast play, if your group reaches a score of two over par, please pick up your ball and go to the next hole.

In an effort to keep the tournament competitive, but more inclusive for all teams in their various forms, we will award the winning foursome prizes in the following format:

THE OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP

(We're good ... or at least we think we're good)

Any foursome, regardless of gender or age makeup, that wants to enter the lowest overall score entered in the appropriate contest category.

THE CHAMPIONS TOUR

(Will be exempt from random drug testing)

Any foursome composed of at least three players who are 50 years or older regardless of gender with the lowest score entered in the appropriate contest category.

THE MIXED "MASTERS"

(Where no one needs to know your age)

Any foursome comprised of at least one - and up to four female players - with the lowest score entered in the appropriate category.

MOST HONEST GOLFERS

(Our pencils don't need an eraser)

Any foursome regardless of its age or gender makeup that has the highest overall score entered in the appropriate contest category.

HOW TO ENTER

At the end of the round, clearly tally and mark your team score and drop your completed score card into the appropriately marked container located in or near the pro shop. Each container will be clearly labeled with each of the four divisions. By placing your card in the specific container, your team will be in competition for the winning score in that particular division.

All of the other rules of the scramble format, including using three drives from each player, will still be in place.
